

Program Outcome-Post Graduate Course In Psychology

PO1: The Post Graduate program in Psychology is an advanced-level program that combines theoretical and practical aspects of understanding behaviour in various aspects of life. The course is based on the Choice-Based Credit System divided into four semesters.

PO2: The program aims at understanding basic and advanced levels of basic skills in Psychology such as Statistical Analysis, Psychological testing, Experimentation, Qualitative data collection and analysis, and behavioural skills to understand, analyze and interpret human behaviour in different contexts.

Program Specific Outcome-Post Graduate Course In Psychology

Knowledge Outcomes-

PSO3: The course is designed in such a way that it covers theoretical understanding of almost all the areas of Psychology.

PSO4: In semesters 1 and 2, the students get knowledge of compulsory papers such as cognitive psychology, social psychology, Quantitative methods, Motivation and Emotion, Advanced research methods, Physiological psychology, and personality theories.

PSO5: In Semesters 3&4, students get knowledge about specialized papers and also get an opportunity to do research in the form of a Dissertation.

PSO6: Out of various specializations offered by the University such as Clinical Psychology, Organizational Psychology, Developmental Psychology, Health Psychology, Positive Psychology, and Applied Social Psychology, the students select 4 theory papers.

PSO7: Practicals remain compulsory and if students opt for Dissertation, they get a chance to research in these specialized areas.
